INTRODUCTION

A Division of The Indian Institute of Welding has been accredited by International Institute of Welding (IIW) as its only '**Authorised Nominated Body**' (ANB) in India (To be referred to as IIW-India ANB) to operate its various international schemes and award International Welding Diplomas..

The Following IIW Diplomas are offered

- ❖ **International Welding Coordination Personnel:**
IWE, IWT, IWS & IWP
- ❖ **International Welding Inspection Personnel:**
Basic, Standard & Comprehensive levels
- ❖ **International Welder:**
Fillet, Plate and Tube/Pipe in various processes & materials

Routes for Welding Coordination Qualifications (IWE, IWT, IWS & IWP)

Standard Route Eligibility: Involves study by candidates meeting the IAB approved Access Conditions at an Approved Training Body (ATB) as per full syllabus and followed by ANB conducted examination as per IAB Guideline. This is the route offering the most comprehensive manner in which the syllabus could be covered to meet all the requirements of IAB guideline. These could be a University, Technical College or part of a corporate body with separate training setup suitably isolated from its business operation. Presently only IWE & IWT & IW qualifications are offered through Standard route involving lesson in an ATB.

Transition Route Criteria: Existing professionals in a country doing similar nature of work with requisite qualification, knowledge and experience have an attractive option of acquiring the International Diploma of choice by the Transition Route provided they acquired the specified Qualification Criteria in the country on or before 3.5 years from the day the ANB is awarded authorisation to conduct the course.

Presently this option is available without an end date for IWE, IWT, IWS & IWP for candidates who fulfilled the qualification and experience criteria on or before 03-01-2011 & for IWIP the date is on or before 13-01-2014

Alternative Route: The candidate must have educational qualification conforming to the Access Condition as required for the 'Standard Route' for the appropriate level along with relevant knowledge, training and experience. Candidate is required to apply by filling a detailed Form. His application is scrutinised & approved, based on his declared prior knowledge. The candidate is required to submit a Project Report & acceptance of the submitted Project after interview shall allow the candidate to directly appear for the final Theory, Oral & Practical examination like a Standard Route student without attending lesson in an ATB.

This is available presently only to IWE & IWT candidates fulfilling 'Access Condition' who have 4 years minimum relevant experience in Industry at the appropriate level and involves no study at an ATB.

Functions of Authorised Nominated Body (IIW - India ANB)

To operate the Qualification and Certification Schemes (As applicable) in India on behalf of the International Institute of Welding following are the international rules/guidelines as framed by International Authorisation Body (IAB)

- ✓ Appoint Approved Training Bodies (ATBs) meeting IAB rules and ANB Contract conditions to conduct regular classes to impart the actual lessons & Training following the IIW curriculum and guideline.
- ✓ Control Admission to ATB of all IIW Courses by Standard Route as per IAB approved requirement for India of the relevant "Access Conditions" subject to verification and approval by ANB-India.
- ✓ To conduct and supervise all theoretical/Oral examinations and practical tests after the candidate completes the required training.
- ✓ Administer Alternative Route for qualification including conducting Interview, Examination etc. following respective IAB Guideline.
- ✓ Conduct refresher courses through Transition Arrangement to candidates meeting the IAB (International Authorisation Board- IIW) approved National criteria for India.
- ✓ Award International Diploma and Certificates to successful candidates as applicable.

Benefit for Industry:

- ✓ The IIW qualification system, administered by ANB India provides a pool of welding personnel at all levels, trained to international standard of competency.
- ✓ This will also enable industry to fulfil the overall requirements of ISO 3834 (Quality Requirement for Welding) as well as ISO 14731 (Welding Co-ordination Task and Responsibilities) and NDT inspectors requirement as per ISO-9712 and which will be particularly relevant for export-oriented industries.
