



IWCP : How to Apply for Qualifying by Transition Route

In order to proceed further candidates are requested to visit our website <http://www.iivindia.com> for further details and to make an attempt to verify your eligibility for availing the Transition Route for Qualification as IWCP (International Welding Coordination Personnel) IWE/IWT/IWS & IWP Also given below are few specific links to our website for quick reference.

Please note that the prescribed qualification and experience for the Transition Route option must have been acquired on or before 3rd January 2011 and will not change even after years. If you do not qualify on 03-01-2011, any qualification & experience acquired afterwards is not valid for Transition Route. Candidates who qualified in India in Engineering or working in India covering the experience period can only apply.

Please send a mail to anb@iiwindia.com confirming despatch of the hard copies of application with documents. Candidate is to ensure that ALL the listed documents below are sent together at a time to reach 2 weeks before the course start date for processing including verification of eligibility

1. CV (Latest & highlight your experience in welding)
2. Application Form Duly Filled with Photograph. Please ensure your name in BLOCK LETTERS are correctly spelled and contain Postal Address, E Mail address and Mobile/Tel No.
3. Registration Form Duly Filled
4. Copies of all relevant qualification Certificates (Self attested)
5. Experience Testimonials in chronological order covering the period from date of qualification to the cut-off date 03-01-2011 and up-to to current date duly supported by some proof from employers.

Once candidates' Application along with all documents are fully scrutinised and approved by our Assessment committee (subject to his paying the prescribed fees), he is then required to undergo a four day refresher course followed by an objective type written test and interview on the fifth day of the course. Candidate has to bring some photo identity proof and the Original final qualification certificate for verification at the time of joining the course.

Fees can be paid by DD/Cheque payable in favour of 'The Indian Institute of Welding-ANB' at par at Kolkata or by direct Bank transfer for which specific advice will be given.

COURSE CALENDAR AND VENUE

- The course dates (4 days course followed by 1 day written test and interview) are notified in our Website www.iwindia.com, from time to time at different locations in India.
- This depends to some extent on the number of approved eligible candidates or pending applications for Transition Route for IWE/IWT/IWS. It is always advisable for the candidates to get registered early.
- A candidate having approval of eligibility and making the necessary payment can appear by prior arrangement at any venue convenient to him. Provided on the first day of the course
- A candidate having enrolled and making full payment in advance may be provided with the soft-copy of the study material before the course for early preparation
- In house courses for eligible candidates can also be organised when adequate number of suitable candidates (15) are sponsored by an organisation and infrastructure facilities at a convenient location are provided on agreed terms.
