It is a member Society of the International Institute of Welding. Established in 1966 with its Secretariat in Kolkata, IIW-India is now having 13 branches and 2 centres. The institute regularly conducts various international and national level courses and examinations recognised by Govt. of India and the International Institute of Welding for the benefit of welding fraternity in addition to organising seminars and workshops. The Institute also publishes a quarterly journal, Indian Welding Journal, the official organ of the IIW-India in technical association with American Welding Society (AWS). The Golden Jubilee celebration of the Institute was observed during the year 2016.

It is also, empanelled by DGE&T, Govt. of India, as an assessing body for all Fabrication sector courses under Modular Employable Skills – Skill Development Initiative (MES-SDI) schemes.

The Kolkata Branch of IIW-India is one of the most active branches of the institute having large corporate and individual member base. The branch conducts technical lectures, training programmes, refresher courses, workshops and seminars on regular basis. It has a Centre at Bhubaneswar in the state of Odisha.

OBJECTIVE OF THE SEMINAR

Current trend of automation and data exchange in Manufacturing technologies and its adaption creates Smart Factories. Welding being a 'non-separable' part of manufacturing, is also gearing up to embrace this revolution.

Today, more and more companies are moving towards automating their welding operations, if not entirely, at least in portions. The reasons could be many: to address the welder shortage, improve quality, reduce wastage & rework and eliminate rejection – thereby increasing productivity – **remain competitive and cost effective**. Companies which are planning carefully for automating their welding operations through careful understanding of their welding needs and current processes – including an accurate assessment of workflow and an evaluation of the potential return on investment (ROI) – are achieving success in implementing automation in their plant. The best solution will therefore depend on many factors, including the expected lifetime of the job, the cost of tooling involved and the flexibility offered. Thus, without a well thought out roadmap towards automation amounts to risking valuable time and investments and mostly miss the full benefit of welding automation.

The deliberations in this seminar would facilitate the participants to get updated on these issues and attain requisite knowledge for implementation in their respective industries.
