### **About the institute:**

The Indian Institute of Welding (IIW–India) is the premier professional institute in India in the field of material joining technology and allied areas. It is a member Society of the International Institute of Welding (IIW). Established in 1966 with its Secretariat in Kolkata, IIW-India is now having 13 branches, 2 centres and 13 Students' Chapters. The institute regularly conducts various international and national level courses and examinations recognised nationally and internationally for the benefit of welding fraternity in addition to organising seminars and workshops. The Institute also publishes a quarterly journal, Indian Welding Journal, the official organ of the IIW-India, in technical association with American Welding Society (AWS). The Golden Jubilee celebration of the Institute was observed during the year 2016.

IIW-India has obtained accreditations from the International Institute of Welding as the Authorised Nominated Body (ANB) to qualify personnel in accordance with ISO 14731 and as the Authorised Nominated Body for Company Certification (ANBCC) to certify organisations in accordance with ISO 3834.

IIW-India also conducts its own welder certification programme under National Welding Training and Certification Scheme (NWTCS). Director general of Training (DGT), under the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Govt. of India, has empanelled IIW-India as an Assessing Body for MES courses under Skill Development Initiatives (SDI) in welding. Similarly, IIW-India is also empanelled by NSDC as the Assessing Body for certification of welders under PMKVY schemes under various Sector Skill Councils.

The Kolkata Branch of IIW-India is one of the most active branches of the institute in Eastern India having large corporate and individual member base. The branch conducts technical lectures, training programmes, refresher courses, workshops and seminars on regular basis. It has a Centre in Bhubaneswar in the state of Odisha and 2 Students' Chapters in Kolkata and Bhubaneswar.
