SPECIAL PROCEDURE FOR ATTENDING ONLINE PROJECT INTERVIEW & PRIOR KNOWLEDGE VERIFICATION

1. Project Interview:

- a. Prior knowledge: For each Alternative Route candidate, it is mandatory to check his claimed prior knowledge seeking exemption from attending any course at an ATB (or seeking selective exemption) based on his/herself-assessment of knowledge, followed by practical experience gained subsequently during actual job in a welding covering various processes, materials, application and quality & safety related issues. (Ref: Application Form: ANB-INDIA:F:CAF:44)
- b. The goal of the "Project Interview" will be to find out the degree of personal involvement of the candidate in the identification of the specific problem/case for detailed study and analysis. These should be backed up by the conduct of actual experiments, duly recorded and supported by documents and lab reports leading to a logical conclusion.
- c. Online Video Platform: The on line interview will be using MS-Team/Google Meet or any other suitable platform which will be intimated to candidates in advance.
- d. Hardware, Software, Broadband: Candidates must ensure the availability of suitable hardware with camera and microphone, adequate processor and RAM and have adequate data package. *This is solely the responsibility of the candidate and they must check and test their system prior to participation.* Each 1 hr. interview may consume about 2 GB as indicative and we suggest stable broadband symmetrical connection of about 3-4 mbps or higher & power backup.
- e. The assessment of the interview board is deemed to be binding on the candidate but subject to the provision of raising formal complaint in writing giving specific ground for objection.

INFORMATION ONLY FOR NEXT STAGE

2. **Final examination:** On being successful in the step above, the candidate is finally allowed to appear for the Final examination appropriate to his level of IWE/IWT which is similar to standard Route Examination for each module consisting of written examination and oral examination.
 - a. The examination will be based on the learning as expected based on the guideline IAB-252
 - b. Date, Time & Location of the written Test has to be at a secured place under direct invigilation following IAB rule as applicable at the time of conducting the examination which will be communicated well in advance.
 - c. The Oral Examination may be in person or through online means as may be allowed by IIW-IAB at the time, based on any exemption due to the pandemic situation and shall follow the prescribed procedure to ensure fair assessment and also to avoid any malpractice.
3. **Award of Diploma:**
 - a. Condition for award of Diploma: The candidate has to be successful in both the Final written and Interview to be eligible for the diploma for which he fulfilled the eligibility.
 - b. Re-examination/Downgrade: At the discretion of the **Examination Committee** after review the candidate may be offered a lower level of qualification say IWT in place of IWE. The candidate may exercise this option or if allowed may apply for re-examination after fulfilling certain conditions.
 - c. The Diploma of International Institute of Welding will be issued after the examination is over and if there are no irregularities reported during any stage. Any negative report will make the candidate ineligible for any IIW Diploma apart from any other action that may be deemed necessary.
