GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Indian Institute of Welding conducts the “**National Best Welder Competition for Women**” every year to inspire and enhance the skill of woman welders.
2. **This competition is open to all and FREE.** The desirous candidates are required to contact the nearest Branch.
3. The Branches to propose one person as the single point of contact (SPOC) for this competition.
4. The industries may conduct the competition by themselves and may send the nominations (Winners only) directly for final; however, they have to intimate respective IIW-India Branches for the witness and assessment.
5. Carrying out the competition by the Branches will be the complete responsibility of Branch Management. Also, they will witness the competition to be held in different industries in their jurisdiction.
6. The preliminary competitions will be conducted by different Branches of IIW-India. The **Winners** from Branch level competitions are eligible to take part in the National Final.
7. **The candidates are allowed to participate in one category only. The past Winners of the National level Competition are not eligible to take part in the same category.**
8. The preliminary competitions should be completed within **25th of November 2023**, so that the name of the Winners can be sent for the National level competition latest by the **30th of November 2023**. **No entries for National Finals will be entertained thereafter.**
9. The National Final for the Best Women Welders Competition will be held in Bengaluru, tentatively between **19th to 22nd of December 2023** (to be intimated later).
10. The candidates selected for the National Final will be provided with free Boarding and Lodging by the Organisers for a maximum of 2 days.
11. The result of the Finals will be declared within one week after the National Finals, and the prizes will be distributed during the Inaugural Session of the International Congress, on **22nd of January 2024, in Bengaluru.**
12. The Best Women Welders (Winners & Runner-up) selected at Finals will be given the “**Best Women Welder Award**”, which includes a Cash prize and a certificate for each Category.
13. The Winners of National Finals are eligible for taking part in the International Competitions, subject to the discretion of IIW-India and the Rules & Regulations of the Organisers, which will be intimated later.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Must be able to read and write in English and / or in any Indian Language.
2. Must have minimum 1 year experience in practical welding.
3. Must have basic theoretical knowledge of welding.
4. Must have some knowledge of the Codes / Standards being followed in their workplace.
5. Must be between **18 to 34 years old as on 31st December 2023** (16 years and above for the students).

RULES AND REGULATIONS

General:

1. Only one set of pre-prepared test coupon (four plates or two pipe pieces) shall be provided to each competitor.
2. The welded test coupon shall be assessed through Visual Examination and only the qualified coupons will then be sent for Radiographic Testing.
3. Total Marks: 100 (50 marks for Visual assessment of test coupons and 50 marks for Radiographic assessment).
4. In case there is a tie in marks, completion time will be the factor for winning the competition. i.e., Welder, who have completed in lesser time, will be declare as the Winner.

Material:

Plate: ASTM A36 / IS 2062 or Equivalent

Pipe: ASTM A106 Gr. B / API 5L Gr. B or Equivalent

Dimension:

5. Plate: 250 mm X 100 mm X 8 mm thk. (2 pieces for Butt Weld) & 200 mm X 100 mm X 8 mm thk. (2 pieces for Fillet Weld) for categories I & II (SMAW & GMAW).
1. Pipe: NB 4" Sch. 40 (6.02 mm thk.) X 100 mm lg. (2 pieces) for category III (GMAW).
2. Pipe: NB 2" Sch. 40 (3.91 mm thk.) X 100 mm lg. (2 pieces) for category IV (GTAW).

Assembly and Tack Welding:

1. Single V preparation within 55 ~ 65 degree with root gap and root face as per Welder's choice for Butt welds.
2. Tack welding:
 - a) Fillet welding plates shall be tacked in both the edges and at the centre of back side (15 mm)
 - b) Butt welding plates shall be tacked in both ends of the groove with 15 mm length each
 - c) 4" Pipe shall be tacked in 3 positions with 15 mm length each (except in overhead position)
 - d) 2" Pipe shall be tacked in 2 positions with 10 mm length each (except in overhead position)

Consumables:

1. Category I : E7018 dia 2.5 mm & 3.2 mm (AWS A5.1)
2. Categories II & III : ER70S-6 dia 1.2 mm (AWS A5.18)
3. Category IV : ER70S-2 dia 2 mm (AWS A5.18)

Cleaning:

Grinding is not allowed on back of root and capping run. Hacksaw Blade and brush may be used for cleaning.

Completion Time (including setup / tacking):

1. Category I : 60 min
2. Category II : 50 min
3. Category III : 60 min
4. Category IV : 45 min

Assessment:

1. Visual assessment for all coupons shall be done in accordance with ISO 5817.
2. Radiography assessment (only for the visually qualified test coupons) shall be done in accordance with ASME SEC. IX 191.1.2.
3. Final marks will be provided by adding both the marks of visual and radiographic assessments.

Certification:

1. Certificate of Participation to be issued to each welder at Branch level competition by the respective Branch. Certificates also to be issued to the Winner of each category by the Branch.
2. Certificate of Participation to be issued to each Competitor at Finals by the Organising Committee of International Congress. Award Certificate for the Winners and Runners-Up will be issued by IIW-India HQ,
