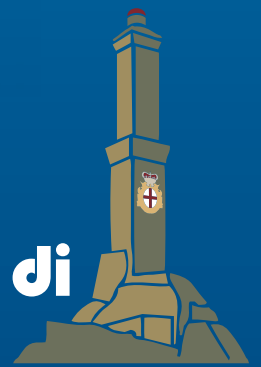

LOCATION AND DIRECTIONS

Porto Antico Area can be easily reached by public and private transport. On this page you will find all the information on how to reach the location based on the different means used.

By car: From the A12 and A7 we recommend the Genova Ovest exit: take the Sopraelevata and follow the directions for the Porto Antico area Porto Antico Area: exit at the first junction, continue past the pedestrian entrance to the Porto Antico area and then enter the avenue leading to the Porto Antico area located next to the barracks of the Guardia di Finanza. Directions for the area's parking spaces.

By Train: For the Porto Antico area it is recommended to get off at the Genoa Piazza Principe railway station. From there Porto Antico Area can be reached:

- On foot in 10/15 minutes
- By bus no. 35 directions Via Vannucci, get off at Gramsci 2 / subway Darsena
- Or bus n. 1, starting from the Marittima / Principe Fs, to Piazza Caricamento
- By underground directions Brignole, stop San Giorgio.

If you prefer the Genova Brignole train station, the Porto Antico Area can be reached:

- By bus no. 13, direction Turati / Metrò San Giorgio stop Piazza Caricamento
- By underground direction Brin, stop San Giorgio

By plane: From the Cristoforo Colombo airport can be reached:

- By taxi
- By bus with the Volabus – Piazza De Ferrari stop. The ticket costs € 6.00 and can be purchased on board.

PARKING

Attention: in conjunction with the first weekends of spring, scheduled events and public holidays, the Porto Antico area will be the subject of a large turnout of the public. This may cause traffic entering and exiting the Porto Antico car parks. To limit the problems, here are our tips:

- **download the Porto Antico app** to check the real time availability of our car parks (Calata Gadda, Cannoniere, Mercanzia, Porta Siberia and Autosilo)

The International Institute of Welding (IIW) was founded in 1948 by the welding institutes/societies of 13 countries who considered it crucial to make more rapid scientific and technical progress possible on a global level.



The IIW's Mission is to operate as the global body for the science and application of joining technology, providing a forum for networking and knowledge exchange among scientists, researchers and industry. Through the work of its 23 Technical Working Units, the organization's technical focus encompassed the joining, cutting and surface treatment of metallic and nonmetallic materials by such processes as welding, brazing, soldering, additive manufacturing thermal cutting, thermal spraying, adhesive bonding and micro joining.

Istituto Italiano della Saldatura (IIS)

The IIS (Istituto Italiano della Saldatura - Italian Institute of Welding) is a non-profit private organization, founded in 1948 as an association.



It's a non-profit association with the mission to "promote and support the progress of welding in all its fields in Italy, including related and complementary techniques, and to contribute to its knowledge and dissemination."
